LandAid SleepOut 2025

The LandAid SleepOut, now in its **seventh year**, has demonstrated remarkable growth and evolution. Starting with a single venue in 2018, the event adapted in 2021 by going virtual due to the pandemic. By 2024, it had expanded significantly, with over 1,350 property professionals participating across seven UK venues and from home, collectively raising more than £766,000.

Looking ahead to this February, LandAid is aiming even higher. We plan to maintain the virtual participation option while adding an eighth venue in Liverpool, with an ambitious goal of raising over £1 million to combat youth homelessness in the UK.

Volunteer Role

We're seeking dedicated volunteers to assist with our biggest SleepOut event, working closely with the Event Manager to ensure everything runs smoothly.

Your support will help us reach our goal of raising £1 million to help make sure every young person has the shelter and support they deserve.

Volunteers will work alongside LandAid staff, an Event Manager, and an on-site First Aider, with roles tailored to each shift.

Shift 1 (6:00pm-11:00pm)

involves welcoming participants, helping set up the site, assisting with registration, and supporting the hot drinks station and stewarding during speeches.

Shift 2 (11:00pm-4:00am)

focuses on stewarding throughout the night, monitoring participants' safety and comfort, restocking the hot drinks station, and ensuring the site remains clean and orderly.

Shift 3 (11:00pm-6:00am)

includes overseeing the site overnight and monitoring participants, preparing for breakfast at dawn, and helping to tidy up.

Volunteers in each shift will receive a full briefing and have the opportunity to make a significant impact.

Volunteer Support and Important Information

Pre-Event Briefing: You'll be invited to an online event briefing ahead of the event. This is a chance to meet the team, review the event plan, and ask any questions about your role.

Event Plan and Briefing Materials: You will receive a comprehensive event plan and briefing document to help guide you throughout the night.

On-Site Support: A dedicated Event Manager will be available for guidance and support throughout your shift.

Food and Refreshments: Depending on your shift time, a dinner or breakfast will be provided, with hot drinks available throughout the night to keep you warm and energised.

LandAid Merchandise: Each volunteer will receive LandAid-branded gear, including a beanie, a merch item, and a hi-vis vest for easy identification on site.

Health and Safety

Weather Preparedness: The venue is intentionally exposed to the elements, so please dress warmly and layer up for comfort.

Commitment to the Full Shift: This will be a long night, and you'll be needed for the entire duration of your assigned shift.

On-Site Safety Personnel: A first aider and security personnel will be on-site throughout the event to ensure a safe environment for everyone.
