Malia's Story

Malia was made homeless at just 16 years old. She had been moving between her mum and dad for some time, and their relationship had broken down to the point where she had nowhere else to turn.

Malia approached the local council and was referred to her local youth homelessness charity and LandAid Partner, End Youth Homelessness, Aberdeen Foyer. The Foyer was able to cover the cost of her first month's rent and also helped cover some of the refurbishment costs to keep the flat warm for winter and feel like a home.

Malia had never lived in a space that wasn't temporary before, so was incredibly happy to receive this support. She said "Everyone needs help from time to time. It does get better; you just have to ask. Now I have so much support on my life, I don't know what to do with it!"







ANY OTHER QUESTIONS?
